





• Mirage Ring







- Structure: Glossy aluminum sheet / iron sheet - Glossy finish
- Floor and interior walls made of wood (pine) or cedar board
- Body of rings: composite sheet with mirror finish - Outer ring: matte black sheet
- Connections: bolts and nuts - stainless steel or plastic connection clamp
- Portable design and easy assembly
- Estimated cost: Materials: CAD 5,000 - Labor cost: CAD 10,000
