







ILLUSION OF HEAT





A geometry of fragmented layers forms a seemingly solid place, yet it constantly dissolves in amber light and shifting planks. The feeling of warmth is evoked by the wood, surrounded by an illusion of heat that flickers like fire on snow. The central mirrored wall becomes a window of ambiguity—structure and reflection merge, breaking the boundaries of reality. Recycled HDPE wooden beams sway gently in the wind, animating the space and reflecting fragments of memory—tangible, yet unreal. People slow down, sensing the movement and light as they walk and touch the panels. Children chase reflections along the slopes and corners; adults capture the illusion in photographs. The cold remains constant, but nothing inside does. Everything shifts with time, reflection, motion, and touch. This design emphasizes movement, perception, and the illusion of sensory and tactile experience.

-Floor area: 4.0 m x 2.0 m ($\approx 8 \text{ m}^2$)
 -Height: 3.5-4 m
 -Main structure: OSB (local material) - Plast wood - Aluminum profile
 -Moving components: Recycled wood panels (HDPE light plastic) - Hanging sheet metal fastener
 -Reflective core: Mirror coated aluminum composite sheet (weatherproof, 4 mm)
 -Cover: Amber polycarbonate panels
 -Assembly and installation in m
 -Estimated cost: Materials: CAD 4,000 - Labor cost: CAD 80,000
